Criteria

Nominees will be a General Contractor member of the Moncton Northeast Construction Association, who has made an outstanding contribution to the New Brunswick's Construction Industry.

- Must be a member in good standing of the association.
- Must have completed at least one qualifying project within the last 12 months.
- Projects may be commercial, institutional, industrial, residential, or civil/infrastructure.
- Self-nominations and third-party nominations are accepted.

 - Company background
 - Year business established
 - Products and/or services offered
- **Quality of Work:** Superior craftsmanship and attention to detail (40 points)
 - Project description
 - Challenges encountered
 - Solutions implemented
 - Client or general contractor feedback
 - Photos (before, during, and after if applicable)
 - Evidence of delivering on time and within budget
- **Innovation:** Use of new techniques, materials, or processes (20 points)
 - New technologies
 - Prefabrication
 - BIM coordination
 - Sustainable practices
 - Productivity improvements

- Unique solutions to complex challenges
- **Collaboration:** Strong relationships with sub-contractors and project teams (15 points)
 - Testimonials
 - Repeat business
 - Collaboration with owners, consultants, and general contractors
 - Communication and responsiveness
- **Professionalism:** Reliability, integrity, and client satisfaction (15 points)
 - Responsiveness
 - Technical support
 - Reliability
 - Problem-solving
 - Long-term client relationships
- **Community Impact:** Positive contributions to local communities (10 points)

 - Volunteer work
 - Community projects
